PBHA's Summer Urban Program (SUP)

Founded in 1904, the Phillips Brooks House Association (PBHA) is a student-led independent nonprofit organization at Harvard University that engages 1,600 students in more than 70 public service programs and benefits more than 10,000 constituents in Boston and Cambridge. The Summer Urban Program (SUP) began in 1980. Since then, PBHA's summer programming has grown to include 12 transformative day camps in Boston and Cambridge.

SUP serves more than 900 low-income children and teens from the Greater Boston area each summer. Each camp's common focus is strengthening children's academic skills, particularly in science, math, and literacy; developing campers' self-confidence; and increasing sensitivity towards cultural, racial, and ethnic diversity. These camps also provide vital summer jobs for high school students in these communities who serve as Junior Counselors. The camps are organized and staffed by students, collaborating with community members and supported by professional staff. SUP offers low counselor-to-student ratios and a heavy focus on academic activities, for no more than \$100 enrollment fee per child for the entire seven weeks of camp.

SUP is not just camps in the community but community camps. Everything we do is based on and embedded in our tight-knit communities and their rich histories. Each summer, SUP makes an enormous difference in the lives of the directors, counselors, campers, and families who participate. As SUP has grown in the past several summers, so has PBHA's need to raise vital funds for these life-changing camps.
